**RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND
DELIVERY OF ONE (1) LOT COLORED CARBONLESS PAPER WITHOUT
FIBER**

WHEREAS, on 30 January 2020, Mr. Michael J. Dalumpines, Chairman and President, as Head of the Procuring Entity, approved the Annual Procurement Plan ("APP") for CY 2020 of APO Production Unit, Inc. ("APO") upon favorable recommendation of the Bids and Awards Committee ("BAC");

WHEREAS, included in the approved APP of APO for CY 2020 is the *Supply and Delivery of One (1) Lot Colored Carbonless Paper without Fiber (PB-01-20)*. The Approved Budget for the Contract ("ABC") for the said project amounts to **Twenty Million Six Hundred One Thousand Pesos (PhP20,601,000.00)**;

WHEREAS, in compliance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act ("RA") No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", the BAC Secretariat advertised the Invitation to Bid for the *Supply and Delivery of One (1) Lot Colored Carbonless Paper without Fiber* under Public Bidding No. 01-20 (PB-01-20) in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), APO Website (www.apo.gov.ph), and in conspicuous place at the premises of the APO Production Unit, Inc. last 11 February 2020;

WHEREAS, likewise in furtherance with the pertinent provisions of RA No. 9184 that will ensure the transparency of the process, observers from the Commission on Audit (COA) Resident Auditor, as well as observers from the private sector were invited to observe and witness the conduct of the Pre-Bid Conference and the Submission and Opening of Bids as scheduled;

WHEREAS, on 19 February 2020, BAC convened for the scheduled Pre-Bid Conference and seven (7) prospective bidders attended the said proceedings which were represented by Ms. Delia Silvano and Mr. Constante Lapitan of Kolonwel Trading, Ms. Analisa Alvarez of Metro Paper Converter Corp., Ms. Lhen Villanueva and Ms. Glenda Cabanus of Asia Prime Commodities, Mr. Winston Uy of EMBU Integrated and Trading Corp., Mr. Joseph Tan of Nation Paper Products, Mr. Victor Chan of Triplex Enterprises, and Ms. Aiza Garcia of Niclao Trading;

WHEREAS, on 2 March 2020, the scheduled deadline for the Submission and Opening of Bids, the BAC received five (5) bid proposals from **Young’s Paper Sales, Inc., Kolonwel Trading, Advance Computer Forms, Inc., EMBU Integrated and Trading Corp., and Metro Paper Converter Phils. Corp.** During the preliminary examination of bids, the BAC checked the submitted documents against the checklist of required documents to ascertain if they are all present;

WHEREAS, the BAC using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion found and rated passed the 1st envelope containing the Technical Components of **Young’s Paper Sales, Inc., Kolonwel Trading, Advance Computer Forms, Inc., EMBU Integrated and Trading Corp., and Metro Paper Converter Phils. Corp.** for complying with the all the requirements stated in the bidding documents and the provisions of RA No. 9184.

WHEREAS, BAC proceeded with the opening of the 2nd envelope using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion and therefore found and rated passed the 2nd envelope containing the Financial Components of **Young’s Paper Sales, Inc., Kolonwel Trading, Advance Computer Forms, Inc., EMBU Integrated and Trading Corp., and Metro Paper Converter Phils. Corp.** with bid proposals of as follows;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by **Advance Computer Forms, Inc.**, as the Lowest Calculated Bid, has been found to be responsive;

WHEREAS, considering the recent Pandemic brought by COVID-19, the procurement timelines for the Public Bidding is hereby recommended for extension specifically in the delivery of goods due to the urgency of the project at hand. (Please see Annex “D” for the Revised Schedule of Requirements);

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the BAC, hereby RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a) To **DECLARE** that **ADVANCE COMPUTER FORMS, INC.** as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder for the **Supply and Delivery of One (1) Lot Colored Carbonless Paper without Fiber (PB-01-20)**;
- b) To **RECOMMEND** for approval and award of contract by the **HOPE** of APO Production Unit, Inc. the foregoing findings.
