






This resolution shall take effect immediately.

**BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE**

**RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE  
PROCUREMENT OF EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (8,500)  
KILOGRAMS OF BOOK PAPER 60 GSM, 25"RW THROUGH NEGOTIATED  
PROCUREMENT (SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT) UNDER SECTION 53.9  
OF THE REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF  
REPUBLIC ACT (RA) NO. 9184**

**WHEREAS**, on 7 January 2013, Mr. Jaime H. Aldaba, as the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE), approved the 2013 Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of Asian Productivity Organization (APO) Production Unit, Inc. upon favorable recommendation of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) of the APO Production Unit, Inc.;

**WHEREAS**, included in the 2013 APP of APO Production Unit, Inc. is the Procurement of eight thousand five hundred (8,500) kilograms of Book Paper 60 GSM, 25"RW (maximum of 35" roll diameter) for the production of Department of Budget and Management General Appropriations Act (DBM-GAA) Official Gazette and House of Representatives (HOR) - GAA Enrolled Copy which shall be undertaken through Negotiated Procurement (Small Value Procurement) under Section 53.9 of the IRR of RA No. 9184. The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the said project amounts to Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (**PhP 450,000.00**);

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with Section 21.2 of the IRR of RA 9184, BAC Secretariat posted the request for quotation in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and conspicuous place reserved for this purpose in the premises of the Procuring Entity concerned for seven (7) calendar days on 25 October 2013;

**WHEREAS**, on 25 October 2013, the BAC Secretariat sent Requests for Quotation (RFQ) for the Procurement of eight thousand five hundred (8,500) kilograms of Book Paper 60 GSM, 25"RW (maximum of 35" roll diameter) to the following suppliers, viz;

1. Papermart Corporation
2. TR Paper Products, Inc.
3. Metro Paper Converter Philippines Corporation

**WHEREAS**, prior to the date of deadline (1 November 2013), quotations from three (3) suppliers were obtained by the BAC Secretariat, attested by the accomplished RFQs certified as correct by the BAC Canvasser (Please see Annexes A, B and C);

A. Papermart Corporation	PhP 484,500.00
B. TR Paper Products, Inc.	PhP 439,450.00
C. Metro Paper Converter Philippines Corporation	PhP 448,800.00

**WHEREAS**, the quotation submitted by Papermart Corporation was automatically disqualified for tendering a quotation higher than the ABC. Further, Metro Paper Converter Philippines Corporation was not considered for the award of contract for tendering a quotation that was only second lowest among the three (3) suppliers who submitted their quotations;
